## EFFECTIVE HOMEOPATHIC RESOLUTION OF CHRONIC SINUSITIS AT DR BATRA'S

## CASE PROFILE

Mast XYZ, an 8-year-old male, presented with his parents, complaining of a left ear infection for the past 6 days, along with preauricular sinusitis. The patient reported no itching but noted the presence of pus. There was no fever. The condition appeared suddenly and has been progressively worsening. He experiences severe symptoms 2 to 3 times a month. The child has a history of recurrent cold and cough since childhood, with persistent nasal blockage, sneezing, and a runny nose, particularly worsened during the night, with changes in weather, consumption of cold foods like curd and ice cream. Symptoms improve with steam inhalation. There is no breathing difficulty, but he often requires allopathic medications to manage the recurrent cold and nose block.

Though he enjoys playing, he needs the company of others. Despite being good in studies, he can sometimes bite his mother in anger, throw things, or hit when upset. 


